DAY 01; CANADA - TOKYO

Today make your own way to the airport to depart on your overnight flight to Japan.

DAY 02; TOKYO ARRIVAL (-/-/-)

Welcome to Tokyo! Upon arrival at Narita/ Haneda International Airport today, you will be met by our representative and assisted to board transfer to your hotel (Standard Check-In time is 14:00 hrs. Early check-in is subject to availability).

DAY 03; TOKYO (B/-/-) Breakfast at hotel.

Today enjoy a guided city tour of Tokyo, a diverse collection of everchanging neighborhoods, where futuristic modern districts peacefully coexist with quiet, warm neighborhoods from the past. Your first stop will be at Zojoji Temple, standing next to Tokyo tower, it gives you a perfect backdrop for your photograph, a perfect representation of modern meeting the past. Apart from its impressive gateway dating back to 17th century, pay attention to hundreds of Jizos traditional stone deities dressed in hats and robes and believe to protect and guide travellers, provide strength to weak and in danger. Next stop will be the Shibuya Crossing, believed to be the most crowded junction in the world. Then visit Meiji Shrine, dedicated to deified spirits of Emperor Meiji and his wife. Continue to the elegant street, Omotesando and see the majestic Imperial Palace and its Gardens. Stop to visit the famous Nijubashi Bridge. Pass through the district of Akihabara, the "electric city" known as the centre of Japanese Manga and Anime culture. We will then head to Tokyo Skytree, Tokyo's tallest structure where you will be able to enjoy fantastic panoramic views of Tokyo (Ent. Tickets not included). We'll conclude the tour in Asakusa, visiting the historic Sensoji Temple and the famous Nakamise Street. The rest of the evening will be at your leisure, where we recommend you spend time at the lively Shinjuku District, where you can enjoy a stroll through its bustling street, renowned for its shopping and vibrant nightlife, and then head to the many local restaurants in the area for dinner.

There are three sumo shows held every day from noon to night. Enjoy an impressive sumo show performed by former sumo wrestlers right in front of your eyes. Explanations will be provided in easy-to-understand terms in Japanese and English. A set of delicious chicken chanko nabe Japanese food set supervised by a former sumo wrestler and one drink! When you leave, you will receive an original souvenir and a photo **with a former sumo wrestler**.



DAY 05; TOKYO - Mt. FUJI - HAKONE (B/-/D) Breakfast at hotel.

Today, you will see the iconic Mt. Fuji. You will be picked up from the hotel, then take a private coach for the tour today. First, take a boat on Lake Kawaguchi, and get a great view of Mt. Fuji. Then visit Chureito Pagoda & Arakurayama Sengen Park, where you can capture its beautiful pagoda with Mount Fuji as a backdrop. Immerse in the beauty of Oishi Park, a great park with an amazing view of Mount Fuji. There are plenty of seasonal flowers but the lavender in mid-June is a crowd favourite. It is situated next to Kawaguchiko Natural Living Center. After tour, back to hotel for overnight. Dinner at the hotel.

DAY 06; Hakone - KYOTO (BY TRAIN) (B/-/-) Breakfast at hotel.

Today you will experience the bullet train ride.

Head to the railway station to board a Shinkansen bullet train to Kyoto, the spiritual heart of Japan. Sit down with your reserved seats in standard class seat which is more spacious and comfortable than ordinary seats and enjoy the amenities offered on board.

Arrive in Kyoto after around 2 hours, meet your private guide and driver at the arrival hall and head to the hotel for check-in.

In the afternoon, visit Jojako-Ji Temple, renowned for its beautiful scenery of colourful leaves in autumn and green blankets of moss in summer. Take a relaxing walk through Sagano Bamboo Grove and then explore the beautiful temple gardens of Tenryuji, a World Heritage Site considered one of Kyoto's best Zen temples.

DAY 07; KYOTO (B/-/-)

Breakfast at hotel.

Proceed for full Day Kyoto City Tour.

Explore Kyoto, the spiritual heart of Japan, with your guide. The highlights include the Kinkaku-ji Temple with a gold leaf-covered top and famed for the perfect mirror image in the pond at the foot of it; the Nijo Castle, home to the first shogun of the Edo Period; the Fushimi-Inari Shrine, where thousands of vermilions torii gates up Mount Inari will lead you to take in its sanctity and tranquillity.

As the tour concludes, be dropped off at Gion, a traditional entertainment district, for chances to encounter beautiful geishas.

DAY 08; KYOTO - NARA - OSAKA (B/-/-)

Breakfast at hotel.

In the morning, head to **Nara** with your guide and spot the highlights of the city. Nara Park, with deer roaming freely on the lawn, is your first stop. You can stop to feed the deer before moving on to Todai-Ji Temple. Constructed in the year 752, it is one of the most famous and historically significant temples in the country, with a 15-meter-tall, bronze Buddha statue (Daibutsu) sitting in the main hall.

Later continue to Osaka. Check in at hotel and rest of the day at leisure. Evening you can stroll through the lively Dotonbori area, home to vibrant neon signs and the iconic Glico Man. It's the perfect spot for food lovers and a must-visit for the best street food in the city!

DAY 09; OSAKA (B/-/-)

Breakfast at hotel.

OPTIONAL TOUR: Full day tour of Osaka

Meet your guide at the hotel lobby and begin your exploration of Osaka. Start with a visit to Osaka Castle, the city's most iconic landmark, where you can learn about the history of feudal Japan and enjoy views of the surrounding park. Continue to the Osaka Museum of Housing and Living, which offers an immersive look into everyday life in Osaka during the Edo to Showa periods through life-sized streets and interactive exhibits. The tour proceeds to the Umeda Sky Building, where you can visit the Kuchu Teien Observatory for stunning 360-degree views of the city skyline. Conclude your day with a visit to Shitenno-ji Temple, one of Japan's oldest Buddhist temples, known for its serene grounds and classical architectural style.
